Position Description – Grounds Officer

JOB TITLE:

Grounds Officer

OBJECTIVE:

To prepare and maintain fields for football games.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Establish and maintain schedule of volunteers to undertake line marking
- Oversee line marking and maintain stocks of line marking paint
- Liaise with the Secretary to establish fixture schedule
- Liaise with Field Maintainer to synchronise line marking with mowing and other repair work
- Liaise with BSRC to promote proactive management of Field Maintenance
- Provide advice to committee on field usage, including wet weather ruling
- Establish a sub-committee of wet weather assessors

RELATIONSHIPS:

- Reports to the President and General Committee.
- Liaise directly with Secretary with any wet weather assessments
- Liaise with BSRC and their appointed Field Maintainer.
- Liaise with the volunteer network.

ACCOUNTABILITY:

- Accountable to ensure the fields are prepared according to FB rules.

ESSENTIAL SKILLS:

- Trained in the art of line marking
- Knowledge of the Football Brisbane rules, including wet weather
- Familiar with the horticultural challenges associated with a shared facility
- Dedicated club person, with ability to corral volunteers to spread the load amongst many
